- Make arrangements to transport your belongings and furniture to your new residence. If you brought it here, take it with you. Find someone who can use items you no longer need.
- If you have a bulky item to dispose of, something that can't fit entirely inside a trash can, you **MUST** arrange its pick up and disposal via New Brunswick's Department of Public Works by calling 745-5104.
- Wait until 5 p.m. the day before your collection day to place trash at the curb. Keep trash and litter off the street and sidewalk.

LIMIT: Three bulky items per dwelling, per pick up.

Violators will face fines up to \$2,000!
