Executive Order 2021-02

WHEREAS, during 2020 the City of New Brunswick made certain efforts to alleviate the burdens faced by its businesses due the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City enabled a wide variety of forms of outdoor dining to maintain safe, and socially distanced dining; and

WHEREAS, the forms of outdoor dining, particularly those on George Street have been a great success; and

WHEREAS, the City Market has requested a continuation to the outdoor dining on George Street; and

WHEREAS, the City shall monitor the conditions on George Street to ensure safety of patrons and fairness to the businesses not directly participating in the street closure; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAMES M. CAHILL, Mayor of City of New Brunswick in the County of Middlesex in the State of New Jersey, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Statutes of this State, do hereby establish the following guidelines:

1. The regulations, conditions, and standards expressed in Executive Order 2020-13 are hereby extended through Sunday, January 31, 2021 at 11:00 p.m.
