Executive Order 2021-03

WHEREAS, during 2020 the City of New Brunswick made certain efforts to alleviate the burdens faced by its businesses due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City enabled a wide variety of forms of outdoor dining to maintain safe, and socially distanced dining; and

WHEREAS, the forms of outdoor dining, particularly those on George Street, has proven successful; and


WHEREAS, City Market has requested a continuation of the outdoor dining on George Street; and

WHEREAS, the City shall monitor the conditions on George Street to ensure safety of patrons and fairness to the businesses not directly participating in the street closure;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAMES M. CAHILL, Mayor of City of New Brunswick in the County of Middlesex in the State of New Jersey, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Statutes of this State, do hereby establish the following guidelines:


1. The regulations, conditions, and standards expressed in Executive Order 2020-13 are hereby extended through Sunday, February 28, 2021 at 11:00 p.m.; except:
 - a. Restaurants and taverns with George Street frontage between Church Street and Paterson Street may once again have outdoor dining on the sidewalks subject to all rules and regulations regarding sidewalk dining.
2. George Street, between Church Street and Paterson Street shall be reopened on Friday, February 5, 2021 to vehicular traffic.
 - a. One traffic lane shall be dedicated to traffic flowing from Church Street toward Paterson Street.
 - b. The other traffic lane shall remain closed to through-traffic but will be available for 15-minute parking for customers and as a loading area for area businesses.
3. All businesses, including those providing music or other forms of entertainment, are reminded that they must comply with the standards of the City's Noise Ordinance set forth in Chapter 8.28 - Noise Control, of the City's Municipal Code.
 - a. Requests for a waiver of City's Noise Ordinance may be submitted to the Office of the City Clerk and will be reviewed and issued on a case-by-case basis.
4. Every day from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. all tents on George Street must be open on sides facing businesses on George Street or must use clear, see-through sides for cross-visibility.
5. Any and all of the above terms and provisions shall be subject to modification, alteration or rescission without notice and at the sole discretion of the City of New Brunswick and its agents.
6. This Executive Order shall take effect on Monday, February 1, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.
