Sealed proposals will be received by the Purchasing Board of the City of New Brunswick, NJ at City Hall, 78 Bayard Street, New Brunswick, NJ. The bids will be opened and read **virtually** on **Tuesday, January 12, 2021** at **10:00 a.m.**, prevailing time for **2018 Water Main Replacements – Phase II, Joyce Kilmer Avenue Water Main Upgrade Project, Specification No. 887-20W.**

The work will be in accordance with the specifications prepared by Mott MacDonald and adopted by the City Council of the City of New Brunswick, NJ. **Vendors interested in obtaining a set of Plans and Specifications should contact the City Engineer's Office at 732-745-5056.**

At the designated date and time, the City Clerk will open and read **virtually**, the sealed bids.

**Please note that there will be no in-person opening of the bids and all bids must be submitted by 10:00 a.m. on the designated day of the bid opening to the City Clerk's Office, 78 Bayard Street, New Brunswick, NJ 08901. Please note if you are hand delivering a bid, that access to the City Clerk's Office is only available via the back parking lot door. Entry past the lobby is prohibited and masks must be worn to enter the building.**

Each bidder is required to bid each item on a fixed unit price basis, which will be maintained throughout the contract.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond payable to the City Treasurer of the City of New Brunswick, as a guarantee that if the contract is awarded to them, they will enter into a contract therefore. The amount so deposited shall be ten percent (10%) of the bid, but in no case in excess of \$20,000.00.

N.J.S.A. 40A11-14, provides that the Governing Body of any municipality may provide the form and manner of approval of all guarantee, indemnity, fidelity or other bonds required.

Bidders must comply with P.L.1963 Chapter 150 (Prevailing Wage), P.L.1975 Chapter 127, N.J.A.C. 17:27, N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., P.L. 1977 Chapter 33 and with P.L.1999 Chapter 238. In addition, all bidders must comply with the Public Works Contractor Registration Act - N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48 et seq., when applicable and comply with the Contractor Responsibility Certification and respond to the Disclosure of Investment Activities in Iran form.
