

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE REVISED GENERAL
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEW BRUNSWICK
TITLE 3, REVENUE AND FINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of New Brunswick:

SECTION I

Title 3, Chapter 3.28, Section 3.28.120 "Parks and Recreation Fees," as to the following Programs, is hereby amended to read and/or include as follows:

A day will equal eight (8) hours. Any additional hours will be charged at the rate of \$200.00 per hour.

A non-refundable Application Permit fee of \$25.00 is required to be submitted with the Application

PARK STAFF OVERTIME CHARGES:

Weekends and Festivals (four (4) hour minimum) \$60.00 per hour

Weekdays/ 3:30 p.m. -10:30 p.m. (four (4) hours minimum) \$40.00 per hour

(Exceptions for City sponsored events,(i.e., Independence Day, Raritan River Festival, etc.)

All fees are to be received by the Recreation Department and made payable to "City of New Brunswick".

A separate invoice will be generated for Park Fees and any overtime fees (if applicable for events). Two separate checks are required.

SECTION II

If any subsection, paragraph or provision of this Ordinance is declared to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such finding shall not affect the remaining provisions hereof which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEW BRUNSWICK TITLE 2, "ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL"

BE IT ORDAINED by the New Brunswick City Council as follows:

SECTION I

Title 2, Chapter 2.64, Department of Police, Section 2.64.260 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.64.260 - Payment for Extra-Duty Assignments

All Vendors shall be required to make all payments for extra-duty assignments payable to the City of New Brunswick. All payments for extra-duty assignments shall be forwarded to the office of Chief Financial Officer of the City of New Brunswick. The Chief Financial Officer shall deposit all funds earmarked for the payment of extra-duty officers, collected from Vendors, into a special escrow fund. The escrow fund shall be established for payment to members of the Police Department performing the extra-duty services. All police officers shall be required to submit pay slips to the Police Director/Chief of Police. The pay slip shall be in a form approved by the Police Director/Chief of Police. Upon receipt of a properly executed pay slip verified by the Vendor, the Finance Department will process the pay slips for disbursement. Extra-duty officers shall be paid on a timely basis.

Except as provided elsewhere in this Ordinance, all police officers working an extra-duty assignment shall be paid as follows:

2021	\$83.50 per hour
2022	\$86.00 per hour
2023	\$87.50 per hour
2024	\$89.00 per hour

In the event that an extra-duty assignment calls for a staffing level of five (5) or more police officers, a Supervisor shall also be employed. Except as provided elsewhere in this Ordinance, the Supervisor's rate of pay shall be fifteen (15%) percent above the hourly rate set forth above (rounded to the nearest dollar) as follows:

2021	\$96.00 per hour
2022	\$99.00 per hour
2023	\$101.00 per hour
2024	\$102.00 per hour

Furthermore, due to the nature of the services provided and the longstanding relationship between the New Brunswick Police Department and the State Theatre, the State Theatre shall be charged the extra-duty rate as set forth below plus an Administrative Fee as set forth in 2.64.270 as follows:

Commencing January 1, 2021	\$62.00 per hour
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The supervisor requirements and 15% differential set forth in Section 2.64.260 shall also apply to the State Theatre and the above rate.

These rates shall also apply to civic and not-for-profit organizations.

Officers shall receive "premium pay" for all hours or part thereof worked in excess of 8 on an extra-duty assignment, for all hours worked from 1900 through 0600 hours, for all hours worked on Saturdays and Sundays, and for extra-duty assignment on Easter, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and December 31st.

"Night-time road construction" is defined as any work within the public right-of-way that takes place between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

The premium pay rate shall apply to all officers regardless of rank. The premium pay commencing January 1, 2021 shall be \$125.00 per hour.

SECTION II

Title 2, Chapter 2.64, Department of Police, Section 2.64.270, Paragraph A is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.64.270 - Administrative Costs

A. In addition to the aforementioned fees to be collected by the City of New Brunswick from said vendor for the payment of said extra-duty officers, the City of New Brunswick shall collect an administrative fee per person assigned to said vendor. In addition, the City of New Brunswick shall collect a fee per hour per police vehicle assigned to the vendor. Said fee shall be used to offset the administrative costs associated with the assignment of City police officers. The administrative fee and vehicle fees shall be as follows:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEW BRUNSWICK, TITLE 8, HEALTH AND SAFETY, CHAPTER 8.40 "SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL"

BE IT ORDAINED by the New Brunswick City Council, as follows:

SECTION I

Title 8, Chapter 8.40, Solid Waste Collection and Disposal, Section 8.40.040-C, "Regulations", is hereby amended to **ADD** the following to Subsection C:

8. New homeowners will be issued two (2) free 20-gallon recycling containers within one (1) year of occupancy if the new homeowners provide a deed proving ownership within the last year to the Department of Public Works.
9. Additional recycling containers can be purchased for \$12.00 for 20-gallon containers and \$18.00 for 32-gallon containers.
10. City/County recycling containers that are damaged will be replaced for free when residents bring the damaged containers back to the Department of Public Works.
