Bicyclist is Seriously Injured When He Strikes a Vehicle's Open Door

On Wednesday afternoon a bicyclist traveling on George Street struck the open door of a silver Toyota Camry stopped on George Street letting off a passenger. This occurred in front of 373 George Street at approximately 4:00pm. The bicyclist, identified as Adolfo Guzman (54 years of age from New Brunswick) received a laceration to his neck when he struck the open car door. The driver of the vehicle (Melvin Martinez-Romero, 31 years of age from New Brunswick) and his exiting passenger (Vicente Telayehuatl-Hernandez, 34 years of age from North Plainfield, NJ) both assisted the bicyclist and drove him to Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital where he was treated for his serious but non-life threatening injuries.

A follow up police investigation determined that the driver of the vehicle (Martinez-Romero) was unlicensed and issued the appropriate summons. Anyone who witnessed the accident, or has information regarding this incident, is encouraged to call Officer Patrick Evans at (732) 745-5005.
