## New Brunswick Police Investigate String of Car Fires

New Brunswick Police Department detectives are actively investigating a string of vehicle fires which have occurred across the city in the last two weeks. The fires are considered suspicious in nature and deliberately set. Beginning on July 7<sup>th</sup> there have been six vehicles fires with the two most recent occurring this morning.

The fires have occurred on Louis Street, Livingston Avenue, Commercial Avenue, Class Place, Remsen Avenue, and Jersey Avenue. The majority of the fires have occurred during the early morning hours.
