**Apparent Suicide Jumper Lives**  
**After Jumping from the Donald Goodkind Bridge**

Today at approximately 10:00am, a 38 year old male from New Brunswick jumped from the Donald Goodkind Bridge (US Route 1 southbound) into the Raritan River. The initial police investigation suggests the man was attempting suicide. As police arrived on scene, they observed the man swimming a shore and exiting the river on the Edison side. The man was interviewed by police and treated by Emergency Medical Services for minimal injuries due to the fall and cold water exposure. The man was transported to Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital for further evaluation.
