Police Investigate Shooting near Remsen Ave. and Baldwin St.

New Brunswick Police detectives are actively investigating a shooting which occurred yesterday evening in the area of Remsen Avenue and Baldwin Street. At approximately 8:00pm a physical altercation between the victim and several other individuals turned more violent and gunshots were fired. The victim, a 16 year old juvenile was shot one time in the shoulder. He/she was transported to Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital where treatment was administered to the non-life threatening injury. The victim is a New Brunswick resident who is registered at an alternative school outside of the City.

The preliminary police investigation suggests that the victim was familiar with the individuals involved in this incident and it stems from an ongoing dispute between all involved. The victim, along with other involved individual(s) identified at the scene, has been uncooperative with the police investigation. The police department would like to emphasize to the public that this was not random act involving innocent bystanders and the investigating detectives ask if anyone has information regarding this incident to please call Detective Bill Coleman at (732)745-5222 or Detective Kenneth Abode at (732)745-5217.
