## Stolen Car Recovered, 2 Arrests Made

On Wednesday, July 20, 2014 at approximately 8:40 am New Brunswick Police Officer Adan Ramirez identified a 2000 tan Lexus 300, stolen the previous day, traveling on Livingston Avenue near Elizabeth Street. Officer Ramirez was able to identify the vehicle utilizing his police cruiser equipped Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR). The ALPR scans the license plates of both moving and parked vehicles and determines if the scanned vehicle has been reported stolen.

After Officer Ramirez was alerted to the stolen vehicle he followed the vehicle and was able to initiate a felony motor vehicle stop in the area of Joyce Kilmer Avenue and Suydam Street. With the assistance of other New Brunswick police officers, the driver identified as Herbert Laws Jr. (21 years of age from North Brunswick, NJ) and the passenger Nadir Laws (19 years of age from North Brunswick, NJ) were taken into custody without incident. Both occupants were charged with Receiving Stolen Property.
