Suspect Wanted for Attempted Murder APPREHENDED

Following up to a press release sent on July 14, 2014, Timothy Ross has been apprehended. During the early afternoon hours of Friday, July 18, 2014 Timothy Ross turned himself in to detectives from the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office. Timothy Ross was wanted for Attempted Murder charges stemming from a shooting on June 14, 2014 on Remsen Avenue. A twenty-six year old female from Hillsborough was shot multiple times as a result of the shooting. Her injuries were not life-threatening.

Charges against Timothy Ross include: Attempted Murder, Robbery, Possession of a Weapon for an Unlawful Purpose, Unlawful Possession of a Handgun, and Certain Persons Not to Possess a Firearm.
