Police Investigate Early Morning Shooting

New Brunswick Police detectives are investigating an early morning shooting which occurred outside of Building 1 at 33 Commercial Avenue. The preliminary investigation suggests that at approximately 12:10 am this morning, the victim (19 year old male from New Brunswick) was shot in each leg by an unknown suspect. The victim told detectives that he was standing outside with some friends when the suspect approached and began firing at them. The victim indicated that the suspect was accompanied by two other individuals.

The suspect shooter is described as a black male wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and white bandana around his neck. He is approximately 5'10" to 6'0" in height and thin build.

The two individuals who accompanied the shooter were described as a black male and a Hispanic male. The Hispanic male had curly hair and was wearing a gray t-shirt.

The victim was transported to RWJUH where he is being treated for non-life threatening injuries. Anyone with information on the incident is asked to contact Detective Brandt Gregus at (732) 745-5217.
