Threat of Guns Prompts Search of House by Police

This afternoon a court approved search warrant was executed at a Sicard Street home after the police received information about possible assault weapons being inside the residence. The New Brunswick Police Department, in conjunction with the Rutgers University Police Department and the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office followed up on information received from individuals who attended a party at the house earlier in the day. The search of the residence turned up two (2) imitation firearms, one of which resembled an assault rifle and the other, which resembled a handgun.

At this time, no charges have been filed against any of the residents of the Sicard Street home; however, the investigation is ongoing. The New Brunswick Police Department encourages anyone who sees something suspicious to report it to the police so that the information can be properly investigated. "If you see something, say something".
