Pedestrian Fatally Struck on Livingston Avenue

Today, at approximately 12:01 pm New Brunswick police officers investigated a fatal accident involving a truck and a pedestrian. The preliminary investigation suggests that Abel Moran Escamilla (53 year old male from New Brunswick) was crossing Livingston Avenue at the intersection of Suydam Street when he was struck by a 2006 Ford Ecoline box truck driven by Daniel Gonzalez (37 year old male from Newark, NJ). Mr. Escamilla was walking in the crosswalk of Livingston Avenue in the westbound direction when he was struck by the truck turning onto Livingston Avenue, headed northbound towards George Street. The injuries succumbed by Mr. Escamilla were fatal and he was pronounced on scene. Summonses are pending following the completion of the investigation.
